*Tuition is \$410/credit hour for residential classes. (Full time residential students takes 32 hours per year.)

*Tuition is \$431/ credit hour for distance classes. (Full time distance students take 19 hours per year, except full time distance students in the Newbigin cohort take 24 hours per year.)

*Tuition is \$410 per credit hour for GCUPM students. (GCUPM students take 6 hours per year.)

*Tuition is \$431/credit hour for MA students. MA students take 24 or 18 hours/yr for 2 or 3 yr. completion.

***Rates for tuition are subject to May 2014 board approval.**

**J-term estimate is \$350 for junior retreat and \$500-\$1000 for middler intercultural immersion.
