



The WTS Trustee Scholar Award

A generous merit-based award for students with outstanding ministry promise

Western Theological Seminary is seeking students who have demonstrated outstanding academic achievement and possess a high commitment to ministry leadership.

When you apply for admission, we will look for the following characteristics:

- Full time Master of Divinity student
- A 3.5 minimum GPA in your most recent four semesters of higher education
- Demonstrated ministry leadership
- An ability to articulate your call to ministry

If you meet the qualifications above and complete your application by January 15, we will invite you to apply for the Trustee Scholar Award. Application essays are due February 1. Interviews will take place at our Scholarship Showcase to be held February 19. Final decisions will be made by March 1.

Amount:

The award is 75% of the annual tuition rate.*

Renewal:

The Trustee Scholar Award is available for these maximum lengths:

- In-Residence M.Div. - three years
- Distance Learning M.Div. - five years

Criteria for renewal:

- Maintain a GPA of 3.5 or above
- Maintain full-time status and progress toward M.Div. degree completion
- Participate in one admissions and one development event annually
- Demonstrate ongoing ministry leadership
- Review by the M.Div. Committee
