Dear Summer Maintenance Crew Applicant,

Thank you for your interest in employment at Western Theological Seminary! I would like to share some additional information about the work of the summer maintenance crew.

The crew has an opportunity to make the seminary campus beautiful, functional, and safe for residents, students, faculty, staff and guests. Your commitment to quality work will play a big part in making that a reality. Aside from the knowledge, abilities and qualifications listed on the job description, I ask student employees to come to work with a spirit of wanting to learn and to be a part of what God is doing at the seminary.

Work hours will be 8:00am – 5:00pm with two 15-minute breaks and a one-hour lunch break. No overtime is planned at this time. You will be expected to begin work with orientation and training during the week of May 1, 2023 and work the entire summer into August 2023. Your end date will be negotiated depending on your personal needs. Limited time off for vacation or academic needs should be cleared with me prior to the start of the season if possible. Lawn maintenance will continue into the fall for those who are interested.

If you are offered and accept a position on this year's crew, I expect that you will make some significant friendships with your fellow crew members. There is a camaraderie that develops over a summer of hard work that can be very special. You will also have the opportunity to learn some new skills that will be beneficial to you as you care for your own home and church.

Consideration will be given first to seminary students and former crew members, second to children of faculty and staff, and third to others including children of seminary students. If you believe you are a good match for our needs, I am eager to hear from you.
