Job Description:

Prepares and leads the Sunday morning worship service for Rose Park Reformed Church (RPRC). In collaboration with the lead pastor, the worship leader will craft a blended style of worship which glorifies God using a wide variety of instruments and the wide breadth of our traditions. Duties will include crafting worship services, selecting songs & liturgy, and leading the congregation in worship with volunteer musicians.

Qualifications:

- Actively growing in their personal faith and commitment to Jesus Christ.
- A commitment to the mission and vision of RPRC.
- A commitment to a collaborative style of leadership.
- Proficient to lead worship both vocally and with a guitar and/or piano.
- Be proficient in the use of a computer (e.g. PowerPoint for Sunday morning slides)
- Maintain the confidentiality and decorum of the church office

Expectations:

- Provide leadership, vision, and passion in the area of worship that is in line with the overall vision and mission of RPRC.
- Take the lead in coordinating with volunteer musicians to prepare and execute Sunday morning worship.
- If available, lead worship for special services (i.e. funerals and weddings)
- Be timely in all communication with secretary and lead pastor in preparation for Sunday morning worship.
- Order, manage, and dispense music supplies (if necessary).
- Represent RPRC, her ministries, and her leadership in a Christ-like way through actions and speech on Sunday mornings and beyond.

Vacation and time-off to be approved by the Executive Team.
